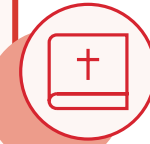

Tips for sharing your story:

- Keep it around three minutes—get to the heart of the matter.
- Use everyday words—no church jargon.
- Be honest and real. Don't exaggerate or try to impress.

JESUS GAVE EVERYTHING FOR ME

ASK THE CRUCIAL QUESTION

Why this step matters



That's why it's so important to ask the question: "Would you like to invite Jesus into your life right now and ask Him to forgive your guilt?"



If you don't ask, most people won't make a decision. You might be surprised how many say "yes" when you simply ask.



ASK THE CRUCIAL QUESTION

What keeps you from asking

- • You don't feel well prepared.
- ~ • It feels unfamiliar and uncomfortable to you.
- You don't want to invade anyone's privacy.
- ≈ • You're afraid of being rejected.



A SIMPLE PRAYER TO ACCEPT JESUS

“Lord Jesus, I believe you are the Son of God. I believe that you died for my sins. Please forgive me of my sins and come into my life. I believe that you rose again from the dead and are alive today. I receive you as my Lord and Savior. I will follow you for the rest of my life. Amen.”

Tip:
Pause after each line so the person can repeat it easily.
